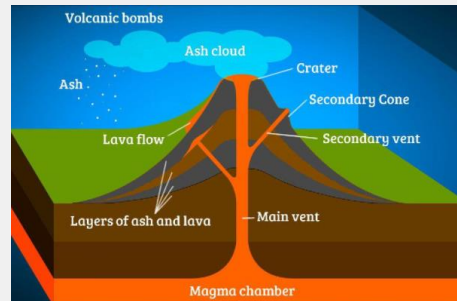

Contour Lines	A line on a map joining points of equal height above or below sea level	✓
Active	A volcano that has erupted recently or is expected to erupt quite soon.	
Dormant	A volcano that is not active but is capable of becoming active later. It is 'sleeping'.	
Extinct	A volcano that erupted thousands of years ago and has no chance of ever erupting again.	
Magma	Molten rock that is formed in very hot conditions inside the earth.	
Lava	The very hot liquid rock that comes out of a volcano.	
Mantle	The part of the earth between the crust and the core.	
Crust	The Earth's crust is its outer layer.
