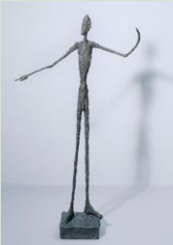

Sculpture - Key Skills

There is a range of different sculpting techniques.

Giacometti tended to make long thin figures out of wire or metal.

Dividing a piece of art into different areas can help to draw more accurate body dimensions.

It is always worth stepping back and reviewing your work to see how it can be improved.

Ideas can be reviewed and revisited to help you decide on what works best.

Alberto Giacometti



Alberto Giacometti was a Swiss artist who was born on the 10th October 1901. He specialised in sculpture, printmaking and drafting.

Vocabulary

Sculpture The art or craft of making statues or other objects by carving, chiselling, or moulding

Dimensions The dimensions are how much space it occupies: its length, depth and breadth.

3D An object can be described as 3 dimensional if it has length, depth and breadth.

Accurate Being precise when drawing or sketching a shape or object.

Dimensional The qualities of a shape such as length and breadth.

Scale How big or small the piece of art is in relation to us.

Detail Each individual part of your piece of art.
