Key Vocabulary		✓
Purpose	The use of the product. The purpose of Death Mask is to look like the dead person so the soul would stay with them in the afterlife.	
Appropriate materials	The materials which have the right properties for the purpose of their use.	
Structure	An object or product made of several different parts.	
Strengthen/ Reinforce	To make something more resistant to breaking usually through reinforcement (by using additional materials).	
Product	An item that is made to meet a set design criteria (plan).	
Papier Mache	A mixture of paper and glue or paper and flour that goes hard when it dries.	
Evaluate	To identify strengths and areas for improvement that can be used for future products.

## Ancient Egypt



The Ancient Egyptians believed in life after death. They mummified the bodies of the dead to preserve them and buried them with objects that they would need in the afterlife, such as food and clothes.

Death masks were made to look like the person who had died so that their soul would stay with them in the after life. The mask also guarded the dead person.

Canopic jars were used to protect the lungs, intestines, stomach and liver of the dead person.
