The artist Chris Kenny likes to use found objects to make his artwork, such as sticks and maps.

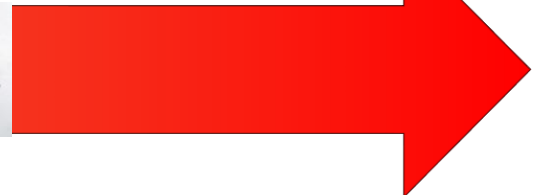
Worry dolls come from Guatemala and are made from wood, wire, wool and textile scraps
