## Key Vocabulary



Plant	Plants are living things that use sunlight to make energy.	
Seed	Seeds grow into new plants.	
Flower	Flowers attract insects and birds.	
Leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to help the plant to make its own food.	
Stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.	
Root	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant in the ground.	
Fruit	Fruit contains the plant's seeds.

Trees are plants that have a woody stem called a trunk.

A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.

An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter.

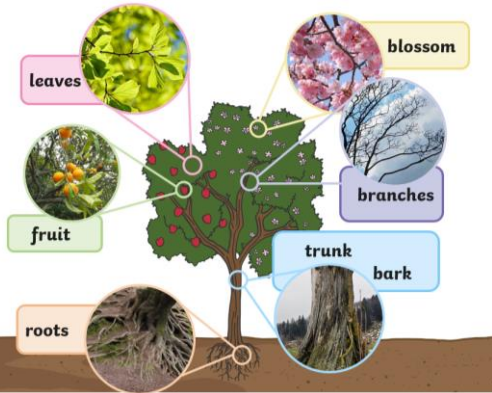

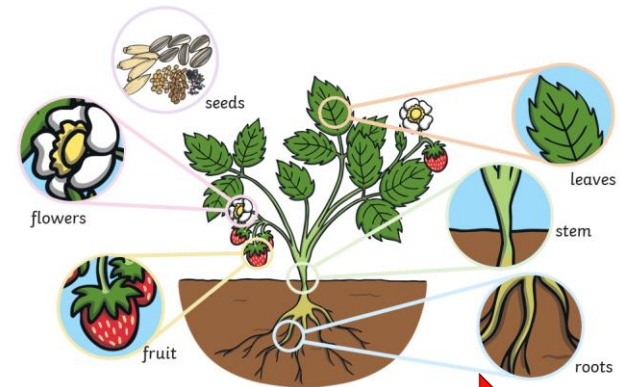
