### Habitats

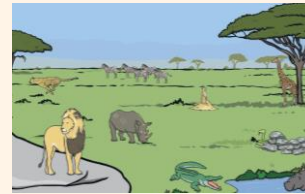


A habitat or micro-habitat is the place something lives.

Savannah is a habitat we can find in Africa.

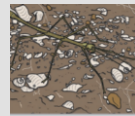


### Links to real life
