Develop your listening skills to recognise different instruments when you hear them.

<b>pulse</b>	the steady beat of the music	
<b>rhythm</b>	long and short sounds or patterns	
<b>pitch</b>	high and low sounds	
<b>tempo</b>	the speed of the steady beat	
<b>dynamics</b>	loud and quiet sounds	
<b>appraise</b>	form an opinion about music based on what you hear	
<b>genre</b>	the type of music e.g. jazz, blues, rock, metal, folk, classical and country
