You can use shading to show dark areas or shadows in a drawing.

Sculptors use a range of materials such as, stone, metal and wood.

Key Vocabulary

Shading	To darken an area by drawing over it a number of times.	✓
Thickness	A line that is wide and not thin.	
Bold line	A darker line that stands out from the rest of the drawing.	
Observing	Looking closely at something to see what it is like.	
Outline	An outline is a line or groups of lines that show what the shape or picture is.	
Faint	A line that is drawn lightly so that it does not stand out too much.	
Shape	Whether something you are drawing is rounded or square shaped.	
Object	The actual thing that you are drawing.
