Tips for Good Rolling:

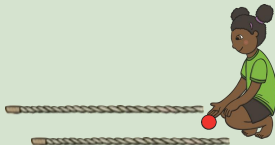
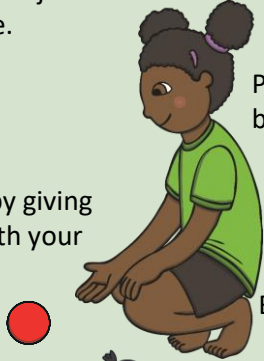
Use the right amount of force to send the object the right distance.

Watch where it is going.

Put your weight behind the object.

Control the ball by giving it little shoves with your hand.

Bend your knees.

- Rolling to a Hoop.
