Modern Italian tiles are made from clay, sand and others natural materials.

Modern Italian tiles come in various sizes and are between 3 and 20mm thick.

Modern Italian tiles use flowers and often are arranged in a symmetrical pattern.

When cross-hatching, remember to add a slight curve to your parallel lines.

When sketching try to hold your pencil in different positions to see which position works best.

Shading	To darken an area by drawing over it a number of times.
Shadow	The dark area behind an object where light is blocked.
Stippling	Several small dots drawn in a circle shape.
Hatching	Drawing closely spaced parallel lines.
Clay	Drawing lots of horizontal and vertical lines that cross over each other.
Ceramic	Ceramics are clay products made permanent by heat.
Grooves	A long narrow cut or indentation in a surface.
Shaping	To pinch and mold the clay to form the correct shape.
Symmetrical	A pattern or design that is identical on both halves when folded.
