God promised to take care of the **Jews** if they followed **God** in return.

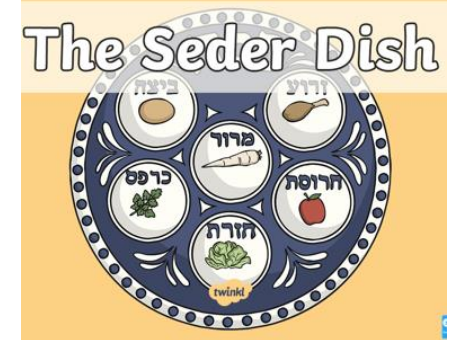
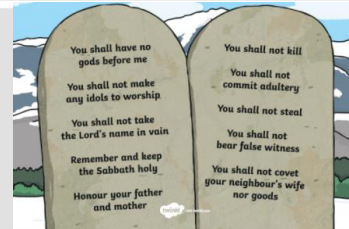
Jewish people live all over the world but **Israel** is a very special place to them.
