## Key Vocabulary



Shading	To darken an area by drawing over it a number of times.	
Shadow	The dark area behind an object where light is blocked.	
Stippling	Several small dots drawn in a circle shape.	
Hatching	Drawing closely spaced parallel lines.	
Observational drawing	Drawing something from real life. Looking carefully and drawing what is in front of you.	
Foreground	The part of a view that is nearest to the observer, especially in a picture or photograph.	
Mid-ground	The point between foreground and background in an image.	
Background	The part of a picture, scene that appears furthest away.

A collage can be made from using a range of materials, such as magazines, fabric and tissue.

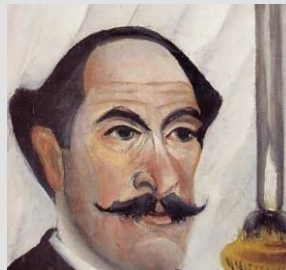
Rousseau used a simple style.
