## Key Vocabulary



Empire	A group of nations or people under one ruler or government.
Human Geography	The study of human interaction with the environment such as buildings or networks.
Physical Geography	The study of natural features of the world such as rivers, coasts, mountains, ecosystems, weather and climate.
Mountain	A land mass with great height and steep sides that is higher than a hill.
Coast	The land next to the ocean; seashore.
River	A large natural stream of water flowing in a particular course toward a lake, ocean, or other body of water.
City	The largest type of settlement, containing lots of buildings and lots of people.
