








Uterus/ Womb	A part inside a female's body where a baby can grow	
Affection	A feeling of liking and caring for someone	
Nutrients	What a baby needs to grow inside a mother's womb	
Ovaries	Organs inside a female's body which produce 'eggs' needed to make a baby	
Ovum	The 'egg' which is released from a female's ovaries	
Puberty	Changes that happen to boys and girls as they grow	
Testicles	Part of a male's body below the penis	
Sperm	Produced in the testicles and needed to create a baby
