Economic Activity and Trade ✓

During the **Industrial Revolution**, there was a mass-movement of people from the countryside into industrial towns and cities.

During the **Industrial Revolution**, there was a major change in how products were made, from small-scale production into large-scale production in factories.

Primary jobs involve getting raw materials from the natural environment, such as mining, farming and fishing,

Secondary jobs involve making things (manufacturing) such as making cars and steel.

Tertiary jobs involve providing a service such as teaching and nursing.
