Tips for Effective Web Searching

- ✓ Use **key words**. e.g. capital city France
- ✓ Use **inverted commas** to find exact names. e.g. "Queen Elizabeth II" "Chinese New Year"
- ✓ **Cross-reference (compare) websites** to check the information on them is **reliable**.
- ✓ **Put information into your own words** to avoid **plagiarism** (copying somebody else's work and pretending it's yours).

Video Editing

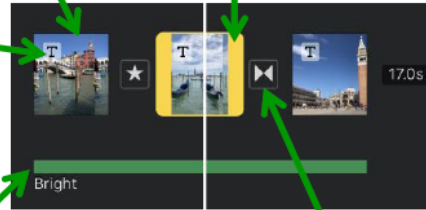
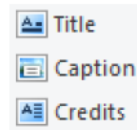


Plan a **storyboard** of your movie first so you know what media to collect and capture for it.

Insert and arrange videos on a **timeline**.

Trim and adjust their duration.

Type on **text**.



Add a **soundtrack** to suggest a tone (e.g. upbeat, scary). Put **transitions** between clips.



Record a **voiceover** narration.



Apply **pan** and **zoom** effects to create motion and highlight things.

Key Vocabulary

Panorama	Move the camera across from a fixed point to capture a larger part of the image.	✓
Storyboard	A series of pictures that help plan a story.	
Soundtrack	A selection of songs and music that go with a film to help create an atmosphere.	
Narration	A person who gives background information to help the viewers understand the story.	
Zoom	To move into a picture and make it larger.	
Cross Reference	To look at different sites on the same topic to help come to a conclusion.
