## The Five Pillars of Islam



<b>Shahada</b>	Profession of Faith – there is only one God.
<b>Salat</b>	Prayers performed five times per day.
<b>Zakat</b>	Giving to charity and supporting the community.
<b>Sawm</b>	Fasting during the month of Ramadan.
<b>Hajj</b>	Pilgrimage – a special Holy journey to Mecca.

## Islam



**Islam** means '**submission** to the will of **Allah**' and a **Muslim** is someone who has willingly submitted themselves to **Allah**.

There are two main beliefs in **Islam**: there is only one **God** and **Muhammad** is the messenger of **God**.

**Muslims** pray five times per day so show their submission to **Allah**.

The **Qur'an** is the **Islamic** Holy book and is treated with great respect. A **Muslim** will wash their hands before touching it.

**Muslims** will use geometric art and calligraphy rather than representations of **Allah** or **Muhammad**.

## The Qur'an



The Qur'an is the original source of God's Law, but **Hadith** provide **Muslims** with practical interpretations for daily life
