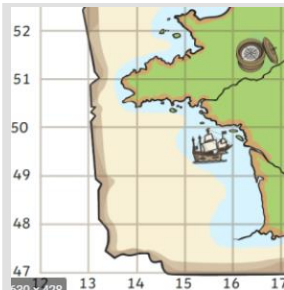
Many of Britain's cities that were targeted in **The Blitz**, were coastal ports or large areas of industry that were important in the war effort, such as Liverpool, Southampton and Birmingham.

There will be **small-scale changes** in the weather features observed in a small area (**microclimate**). This will depend on factors such as **shelter** and **aspect** (the direction it is facing).

The **microclimate** of a place will be used to decide where **renewable energy resources**, such as **wind turbines** and **solar panels** are placed.

Ordnance Survey (OS) Maps cover the whole of the UK. Each map uses the same symbols in its **key** and the Explorer range of maps are the best to use for walking. On an **Explorer map**, 4cm on the map represents 1km in real life.

Key Vocabulary



Microclimate	Small-scale changes in weather features.	
Weather	The daily patterns in temperature, rainfall and other meteorological features.	
Climate	The average long-term patterns in weather features.	
Anemometer	A device used to record wind speed. Usually measured in m/s.	
Thermometer	A device used to measure temperature.	
Four-figure grid reference	Used to locate a grid square on a map.	
Six-figure grid reference	Used to locate a point in a grid square on the map.	
OS Map	An Ordnance Survey (OS) map is a detailed map. There are 403 different maps to cover the whole of the UK.
