fish

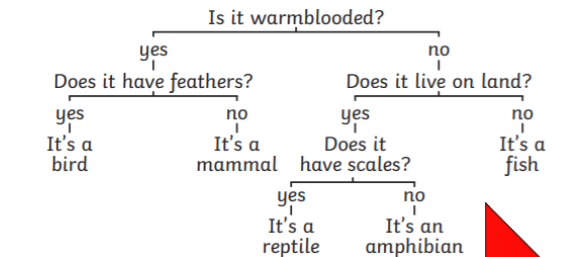

David Attenborough is a naturalist. He uses language, images and diagrams to present information about the natural world clearly.

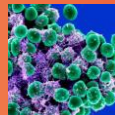


Microbes include:
