Activities

Singing a large repertoire of songs connected with our topics of: Chinese New Year, 'The 3 Billy Goats Gruff' and animals.

Listening to 'The 3 Billy Goats Gruff' story. Being able to retell the story in the correct sequence.

Learning new vocabulary which describes how Chinese New Year is celebrated.

Learning and writing the key words which are used when devising instructions for simple tasks eg, 'first, next, finally.'

Talking about the weather and learning words which describe different weather conditions.

Key Learning

Be able to ask questions to find out more and check they understand what has been said to them.

Be able to express a point of view and to debate when they disagree with an adult or a friend, using words as well as actions.

Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.

Learning what kind words are and how they encourage people.

Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.

Use talk to help work out problems and organise thinking and activities, and to explain how things work and why they might happen.

Connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives eg, because.

Take on different roles in imaginative play, to interact and negotiate with people in longer conversations.

Learn the names for the different jobs people do eg, teacher, builder, doctor.



Key Vocabulary

Learning new vocabulary for topics including; Chinese new year, internet safety, names of different plants and animals eg goats, names of different materials eg, sticks, straw, bricks.

Develop social phrases eg, "Good morning, how are you?"

Rhyming words eg, goat, coat, float.

To learn the words 'story character'.

To learn the terms: non-fiction/fiction
