4. Check the photo looks okay and re-take if needed. Delete photos you don't like.



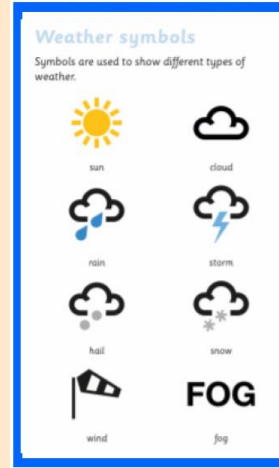
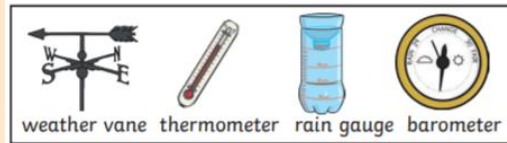

Image	A picture of something that you can use on a device.	

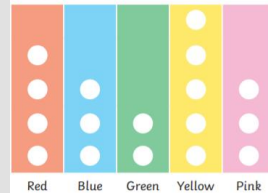
Pictograms use pictures or symbols to represent data. Each picture can represent 1 item or more than 1.

Tally marks look like this:



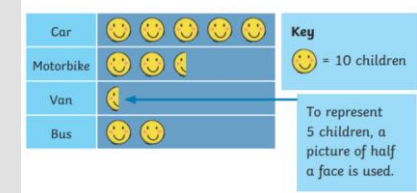
The fifth mark goes across diagonally, like a gate.
