### **Museum of Somerset - Roman Workshop**

Year 3 will be visiting the Museum of Somerset on **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026** to take part in "The Roman Way" workshops.

The trip will include the chance to explore and handle real Roman artefacts, dress up in Roman costume and try writing like a Roman, as well as a chance to explore the Roman exhibits at the museum.

We will be travelling by coach and aim to leave school **promptly at 9.15am**, expecting to return to school by **3.00pm**. Children can be collected from their classrooms at **3:20pm** as usual.

Children are required to wear their school uniform. They will also need to bring with them a rain coat and/or sun cream and a hat, dependent upon the weather.
